Each module includes a 30-minute self-test section at the end.

The running time refers to the length of the module without pausing or skipping any sections. The modules do point the user towards Regulations and Codes of Practice they can refer to, as well as provide a lot of information relating to fire doors and fire door sets. You can complete the self-tests at the end of each module to check your understanding. You can also refer to the modules and re-sit the self-test as many times as you want to. The modules are in depth and there is a lot of information to absorb.

Please note, the running time is for information purposes and to indicate a minimum amount of time it may take an individual to complete the modules and not a recommendation.

After completing the 7 modules you will need to complete a final exam at a Pearson Vue testing centre to receive your certificate.
